**February 9, 2026**

The February meeting of the Village Board was called to order by President Jerry Olig. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of last month's meeting were accepted as published with a motion by Mike Petrie and seconded by Jake Brenner. MC.

The treasurer's report was accepted with a motion by Mike Petrie and seconded by Rick Wagner. MC

Motion by Jake Brenner, seconded by Mike Petrie to pay the village bills. Motion by Jake Brenner, second by Joe Abler to pay the utility bills. Motions carried.

MCO – Tony continues with meter changes, commercial cross connections and updated the LSLI. Kay Schmitz posted the updated LSLI on the Village website. Speedy Clean televised Kommers Street for the 2026 project. PJ Kortens cleaned the Cloudy lift station and snake pit. PJ Kortens fixed the float that failed at the Cloudy lift station. The water discharge report was submitted to the DNR. A new chlorine injector was installed at Well #2. The flow meter at the Waste Water Treatment Plant was frozen for a day and was fixed. Tony will order some needed test kits. Tony commended Dan Merten on 30 years of service with MCO and the Village.

Jim Sippel attended the meeting and is a Candidate for the County Board of Supervisors for District 12. There will be a town hall meeting on March 15<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 p.m. at the Mt. Calvary Hall. Jim and Dennis Stenz will be at the meeting and Sheriff Waldschmidt has been invited as well.

Old Business:

Water & Sewer Utility – Rosie Olig stated 25 late letters were sent out. There were no shut offs.

Witkowski Inspections – There were no permits taken out in the month of January. A question arose regarding roof overhangs for patios and if a permit is needed. Joe Brenner will contact Brian Witkowski.

Fire Protection – Mary Merten will contact other municipalities regarding fire protection for tax exempt properties.

Storage Containers – Mary Merten will contact the Village attorney regarding an ordinance for storage containers.

Banners – Lori Schrage and Mary Merten created a list of where more brackets/banners could be hung. The decision was made to order 15 more brackets. Joe Brenner will order the brackets and Lori and Mary will follow on ordering the additional banners.

New Business:

Liquor License – Noel’s Touch Esthetics, LLC – Joe Brenner presented the Application for a Class C Liquor License. Motion by Mike Petrie to accept, seconded by Jake Brenner. MC

The paperwork was received from Fond du Lac County for the 2026 Ambulance Subsidy Contract. The paperwork was signed and Mary Merten will obtain requested information and will forward to the County.

Other Business:

The contract from McMahon Associates, Inc. was received regarding the General Engineering Agreement for 2026. Motion by Joe Abler to accept, seconded by Rick Wagner. MC

A discussion was held regarding the snowplowing this year. Jerry Olig has had discussions with Adam (Northview Services) regarding the plowing and salting.
