RAISING LIVESTOCK IN THE VILLAGE LIMITS ORDINANCE

No person shall keep or maintain any livestock within the Village limits except for hens. The term "Livestock" in this ordinance is defined as cattle, horses, ponies, swine, sheep, goats, farm-raised deer, poultry, ducks, rabbits, chickens (roosters) or any other wild game.

Any person who owns hens (maximum of eight) within the Village shall obtain an annual permit from the Village for such animal. Such license shall cost \$10.00 per year per household and shall be renewed on a yearly basis commencing on January 1st and ending on the following December 31st. If issues/complaints arise, the Board has the right to revoke the license or decide to not renew the following year.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
